What is Medical Connection?

A number of medical providers working together to provide medical services and referrals for people who may not have insurance.

What is a medical home?

A place where your medical record is already on file. When you need medical attention, your medical history is already there and you don't have to get new tests every time that can cost you a lot of money.

Why do I need a medical home?

When you or someone in your family need medical attention, you can get treatment at the same place, every time, from a caring medical staff who already knows your medical history.

How do I find a medical home?

Find a location near you and make an appointment.

How much does it cost?

There is a sliding fee scale based on income.

What should I bring?

A picture ID, proof of income, and proof of address (a bill.)
